THE TAHOE FUND ACTIVELY PARTICIPATES IN THE LAKE TAHOE PARTNERSHIP, A COLLABORATION OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE GROUPS IN THE BASIN THAT ARE ALL FOCUSED ON PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT THROUGH ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. IN ADDITION, THE TAHOE FUND IS A MEMBER OF THE CALIFORNIA TAHOE ALLIANCE THAT IS DEDICATED TO LOBBYING FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM. THROUGH THESE EFFORTS THE TAHOE FUND MET WITH ELECTED OFFICIALS IN CALIFORNIA, NEVADA AND FEDERALLY TO EDUCATE ON THE NEED FOR MORE PUBLIC SUPPORT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECTS. THE TAHOE FUND SPONSORED AND ORGANIZED THE 2020 LAKE TAHOE SUMMIT, A DISCUSSION OF THE IMPORTANCE OF PROTECTING AND RESTORING LAKE TAHOE. THE SUMMIT WAS STREAMED VIRTUALLY BY MORE THAN 1000 PEOPLE, INCLUDING THE SENATORS AND GOVERNORS OF BOTH CALIFORNIA AND NEVADA . THE TAHOE FUND ALSO HELPS PROMOTE LAKE TAHOE LICENSE PLATES. THE PLATES PROGRAM SUPPORTS HIKING AND BIKING TRAILS AND WATERSHED RESTORATION THROUGH TAHOE'S PUBLIC ENVIRONMENTAL AGENCIES, THE CALIFORNIA TAHOE CONSERVANCY AND THE NEVADA DIVISION OF STATE LANDS.
